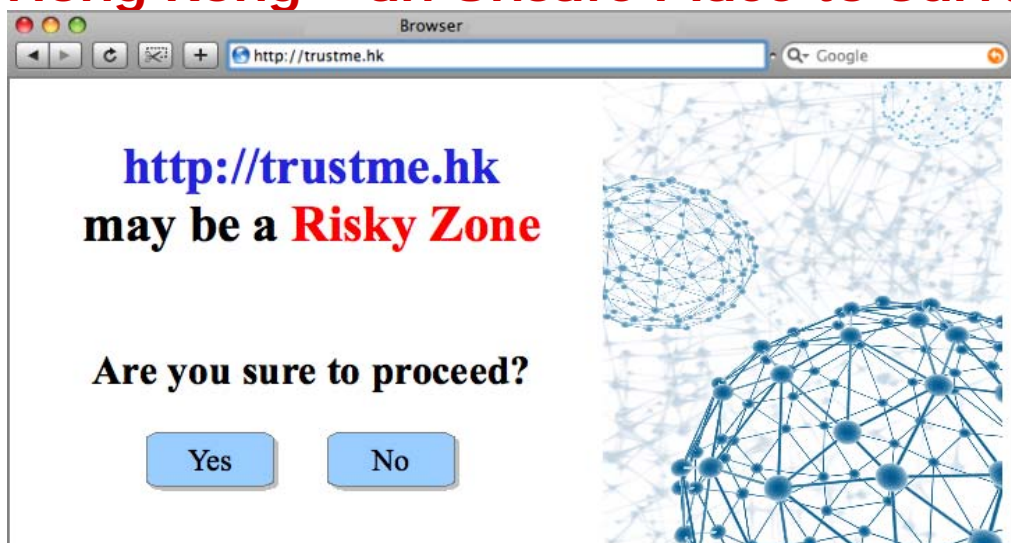


Public Forum
