Before joining the Observatory, Dr Lee was in the IT field while doing a Ph.D. in Physics at the University of Hong Kong. He received his weather education in the United Kingdom. During his many years at the Observatory, Dr Lee has been involved in public and aviation weather services, training and public education, as well as in instruments and observation systems. He was also engaged in special areas like air pollution meteorological studies and monitoring of radioactivity fallouts from nuclear power plants. Internationally, he has worked as experts and chairpersons in a number of technical working groups and sessions under the World Meteorological Organization. The current emphasis in the Observatory's work is on forecasting of severe weather including heavy rain and typhoons, and on climate change.
