#### New telecoms law to take effect



The Telecommunications (Registration of SIM Cards) Regulation is effective on 1 September that to implement the Real-name Registration Programme for Subscriber Identification Module (SIM) Cards in two phases.

The registration programme requires that all SIM cards issued by telecommunications operators of Hong Kong to be used for local communications should have real-name registration within a specified period before activation.

Those operators need to put in place relevant infrastructure and systems for implementing real-name registration within phase one ending 28 February 2022, while the public can continue with the existing use of pre-paid SIM cards and there is no imminent need for real-name registration.

Phase two will begin on 1 March 2022. All newly effective SIM service plan services and new pre-paid SIM cards issued from that date will require real-name registration before activation.
