OFCA and Telecommunications Industry Join Hands in Launching New Measure to Combat Fraudulent Calls

The Office of the Communications Authority (OFCA) today (11 April 2023) announced that in order to raise public awareness of suspicious calls originating from outside Hong Kong, starting from this month, mobile network operators in Hong Kong have started to send voice alert or text alert, for incoming calls with caller number prefixed with "+852" to alert mobile service users that the calls are from outside Hong Kong. The alert arrangement will be fully implemented by all mobile service providers from 1 May. (with reference to OFCA's press release)

To raise public awareness of the introduction of the voice or text alert for "+852" calls by mobile service providers, OFCA just launched a new set of television and radio announcements in the public interest to publicise the measure.
